Fundraising and the Playground Project

Just a word regarding every family's "fundraising commitment": We began including this line item in your tuition agreements last year as an alternative to raising tuition and keeping it this year enabled us to not raise tuition any more than we did. It also gives our families flexibility to determine for themselves how this commitment is accomplished. Some families bring in most of what is needed through our Hoops & Loops event. Others are faithful TRIP users and that does it for them. Still, others chose to give a donation to CHCS. Most families use a combination of all of these. If you have any questions about your fundraising commitment or anything else regarding how things are done at CHCS, please call the school office and we will be happy to chat with you.

Playground Project: We have \$4,950.00 toward our next piece of equipment. Funds received from the following programs all go toward the playground project: Box Tops for Education, Spartan UPC codes, Glen's Cash for Class and Target Rewards. Campbell Soup labels help us to get things for the classrooms as well as small playground items like balls. One of our school families had a great idea and we wanted to share it with you. She brought in about 185 film canisters for us to distribute to our school families. Each canister will hold \$7.00 of quarters. If we could fill every canister, that would be almost \$1,300.00 for the playground project! You can pick up a canister in the school office.
